

#### DURING LENT

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence for people ages 14 and older.

For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal.





For visitation, please contact the rectory if a parishioner is in the hospital. The Eucharist is taken to those unable to attend Mass each week.


